Application for Cornell in High School Dairy Processing Bootcamp

This program is designed for HS graduates who are not planning to attend college in the fall.

In an effort to assist students seeking employment immediately following their high school graduation, the Genesee County Economic Development Center (GCEDC), in conjunction with Cornell University and the Genesee Valley BOCES, is offering a three-day program to expose students to careers in our local food processing industries. The “bootcamp” will provide students with information about careers in local dairy processing companies through classroom presentations, meetings with representatives of local companies, site visits to local companies and will culminate with interested students having the opportunity to arrange interviews with several companies. As part of the camp, students who successfully complete the program will also earn a “Cornell Dairy Processing Bootcamp” certificate from Cornell that can be used when applying for positions in the field now or in the future.

The number of camp participants is limited, so participation in this program will be based upon this application and a school recommendation. The dates for the camp are June 28th, 29th, and 30th. Successful applicants will report daily to the GV BOCES campus from 8am to 3:30pm. Lunch will be provided each day.

Expectations of Participants:

- A strong desire to successfully complete the program to learn about career paths in our local food processing companies.
- A commitment to 100% attendance for 3 days and a commitment to complete follow up surveys after completion of the program.
- All applicants are **required** to submit this application and provide an e-mail address and telephone number by which they can be contacted.
- All applicants are **required** to draft a five to six sentence paragraph on their reason(s) for wanting to attend the bootcamp. Their paragraph may be written on the back of this application or be attached on a separate sheet.
- Applicants are asked to submit an up-to-date resume if they have one.
